### Alex Bennett - Kyoshi 7th dan

Renowned budo scholar, founder of Kendo World magazine, and highly respected international Kendo teacher and author. His deep understanding of Kendo philosophy and technique bridges Eastern and Western approaches to the art.



### Masayuki Norizuki - Kyoshi 7th Dan

President of the Yaizu Kendo Federation with over 45 years experience in the travel industry. A veteran in Kendo exchanges with New Zealand and a committed Jodan player in his university years, he brings a fresh local perspective.

We will take part in at least 5 or more local machi dojo keiko during the week, ensuring exposure  $(\mathbf{i})$ to a wide range of 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th dans. It will be a rare opportunity for you to test and measure what you learn. English speaking 4th and 5th dans will also be assisting, meaning there's no shortage of interpreters or excuses when it comes to mixing with the locals!



# What's Included?



### Personalized Assessment

### Technique Mastery

Receive personalized waza instruction and have your Kendo analyzed on video. You'll also learn kata from a direct Deshi of Chionkenshukan's founder, the renowned Inoue Yoshihiko Sensei.



### Tactical Development

Learn strategic approaches to shiai, jigeiko, and grading examinations with focus on reading opponents, creating opportunities, and decision-making under pressure.



## Mental Strengthening

Develop mental fortitude through meditation, visualization techniques, and mindfulness practices specifically designed to enhance focus and presence during keiko.

Each day includes morning and afternoon training sessions with opportunities for one-on-one instruction, group sessions, and open practice. Evening sessions feature discussions on Kendo philosophy, strategy, and cultural aspects, and 4 of the 5 keiko will be evening practices at local machi dojo.




# Aspects We Will Focus On

- Learn efficient teaching methods for leading practices
- Balance physical techniques with mental development
- Focus on kata and its connection to your jigeiko
- Develop deeper understanding of seme and ki dynamics
- Refine teaching methodologies
- Prepare for high-level examinations
- Cultivate personal kendo philosophy and leadership


